

## BILLERICAY TOWN 0, BISHOP'S STORTFORD 1

Another useful workout for Stortford saw them claim victory at Ryman League Premier Division side Billericay Town, on Tuesday.

In a fast paced but generally scrappy encounter the winning goal came in the sixth minute when Jay Dowie's left wing corner was flicked low into the net past home keeper Jack Giddens and several defenders on the goal-line by Blues central defender Ejiro Okosieme.
